Explanatory Notes

The study can be at any Tasmanian school, Registered Training Organisation or organisation delivering TASC recognised formal learning.

Achieved the TCE: Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained the Tasmanian Certificate of Education.

Achieved an ATAR: Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank.

Attained a VET Certificate: Of the Year 11 students, the number of students who attained a Vocational Education and Training Certificate.
