

## EXTERNAL ASSESSMENT DATES

## FOLIO, PRACTICAL, PRESENTATION, ORAL &amp; DISPLAY

As part of their external assessment requirements, some courses include a written exam, folio of work, oral component, practical task, presentation, or display. To ensure all work is completed and assessed on time, students and schools must adhere to the submission and marking dates set by TASC.

### Students

If your course requires the submission of a folio, project, or supporting documentation to accompany a practical assessment, it is essential to meet the specified due dates to ensure your work is included for marking. Please note that your school may also set its own timeline and deadlines, which you must follow.

Ensure that your work is original, acknowledges all sources appropriately, and complies with the guidelines outlined in your course's External Assessment Specifications or Guidelines. ### Schools and Teachers

Teachers are responsible for uploading and/or verifying their students' work via TRACS for both electronic and non-electronic submissions within two (2) days of the due date to teacher. For step-by-step instructions, visit the [TRACS Resources](#) page.

Schools should regularly run the Folio Status Report in TRACS to track the progress of submissions and verifications, ensuring all student work is submitted for marking.
